Chapter Summary

On Galilee's shore the risen Jesus fills empty nets, feeds His friends, and restores Peter with three questions and a call: "Follow Me." He is seen by hundreds, then gathers His disciples, breathes peace, and promises the Spirit. Authority is His; the mission is clear: make disciples of all nations, baptising and teaching everything He commanded.

Back in Jerusalem He lifts His hands in blessing and is taken up in a cloud; angels promise He will return the same way. The fearful band becomes worshippers-in-waiting, hearts set on the coming power from on high. The story closes not with an ending but a commissioning—eye-witness truth written so that many will believe.

Main Truth: Sent and Spirit-empowered witnesses.

Jesus does not send us on a bare errand; He gives His own authority, His living presence, and His Holy Spirit. Love restores our calling, the Word clarifies our message, and the Spirit supplies our power. The Great Commission is not extra credit for zealots—it is the ordinary life of every disciple. We go because He reigns; we speak because He lives; we endure because He is with us to the end.

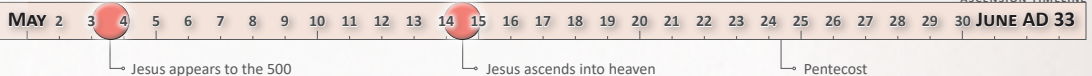

Day 2 Prayer

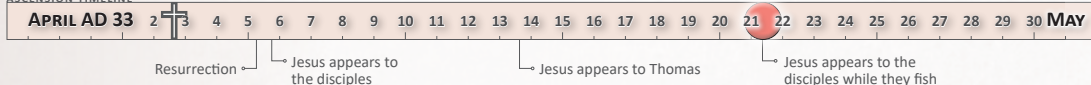
Shepherd-King, heal my failures and re-commission me; make love for You the source of all my service.

We are sent and supplied.

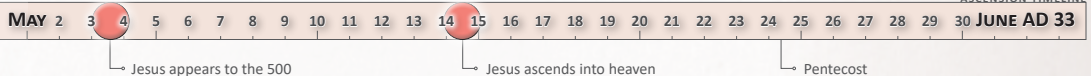
Day 4 Scripture
